





Horse Owner's Dashboard


Horse Owners can manage all horse activities from their dashboard.

Do everything you need right here. From creating client profiles and managing offers you make to members, to keeping track of appointments and giving access to staff and other trusted users.






One Source Horse Quick Tour

Once you have entered your horse information, a high-level summary will appear for each horse. From here you can click on the horse's name to view the full details.






Check the boxes for information you want to share with others via email.






To get started, create your OSH user profile. Check at least one "Account Type" box, or more if needed. The Account Types you select determine which tasks display on your dashboard.




Create as many user profiles as you need. If you are an equine professional you may want separate profiles for your personal and professional activities. Both profiles can be viewed once you log in.




Click to add a new activity.
